Transfer to Belgium under Dublin Regulation



Arrival in Belgium after transfer under Dublin Regulation

You arrive at the airport or at the border. There you receive instructions from the border police. Usually, you must report to the registration centre for asylum seekers at the Immigration Office in Brussels. You lodge your application for asylum there. You must organise the trip to the centre yourself. Registration of asylum seekers: 8:30 am

Accommodation

When you register, your entitlement to accommodation, if any, is examined. If you are entitled, you will be assigned to a reception centre and you must report to Fedasil. At the accommodation facility, food and further assistance will be provided.

There are not enough places in the reception centres. If you cannot be accommodated there, you must ask to be put on a waiting list. This mainly concerns single men.

Health care

If you require medical treatment, bring your medical records as well as translations if possible. This facilitates the further treatment.

Asylum seekers can receive medical treatment from doctors who have signed a contract with Fedasil. If you are not a registered asylum seeker or if you are homeless, contact one of the following organisations:

Vulnerable persons

When you arrive in Belgium, point out that you have special needs, e.g. because you have health problems, you are pregnant, you travel alone with small children or you are a victim of human trafficking or violence.



If you have already been granted protection status in Belgium

Were you already entitled to international protection in Belgium, i.e., are you a recognised refugee there or are you entitled to subsidiary protection? If your residence permit has expired, you must apply to the Immigration Office for an extension (**Centre d'enregistrement Protection Internationale**, address see above).

You must find accommodation yourself. Since you are a recognised refugee, Fedasil cannot place you in a reception centre for asylum seekers. In case of emergency, ask for homeless shelters. Contact an advisory centre that can support you in your search.
